




State-Wide Map





Indiana Manufacturing Facts

Manufacturers in Indiana account for 27.84% of the total output in the state, employing 17.07% of the workforce compared to 11.9% of the Total US.

Total output from manufacturing was \$102.09 billion in 2018.

In addition, there were an average of 541,000 manufacturing employees in Indiana in 2019, with an average annual compensation of \$78,702.82 in 2018.

According to a 2021 Purdue Study the average employee turnover for manufacturing is 40%

Average cost of onboarding a new employee = \$4,000
